USRA 4-8-2 Light Mountain & USRA 4-8-2 Heavy Mountain

To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound 4-8-2 Light Mountain (2003 and later releases) or 4-8-2 Heavy Mountain model (2007 and later releases) you'll want to install a TSU-1100 Steam-2 decoder.



If you have a 4-8-2 Light Mountain or 4-8-2 Heavy Mountain model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 884006. This board will replace the factory PCB that supplies power to the locomotive. **This installation may take one to three hours, and requires work in tight spaces with minimal modifications to the model.**
