

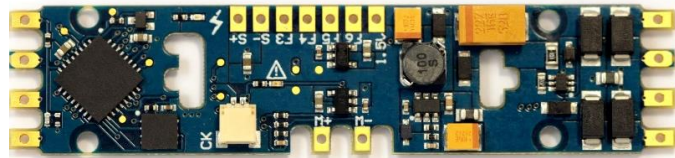
Atlas Trainman® Plus 3GS-21B



To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound 3GS-21B model (announced in August 2009), you'll want to install a TSU-PNP Baldwin & Others decoder.

If you have a 3GS-21B model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 885016. This board is designed to simply replace the factory PCB that supplies power to the locomotive. **You can complete this installation in one to two hours with no modification required to the model!**
