To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound B23-7 model (announced in December 2004), you'll want to install a TSU-2200 GE decoder.



If you have a B23-7 model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 885006. This decoder is designed to replace the factory PCB that supplies power to the locomotive. **You can complete the installation in one to three hours with minimal modification required to the model!**
