To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound Dash 8-40B or Dash 8-32BWH model (announced in October 2000), you'll want to install a TSU-2200 GE decoder.



If you have a Dash 8-40B or Dash 8-32BWH model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 885006. This board will replace the factory PCB that supplies power to the locomotive. **This installation may take upwards of three hours to complete with multiple modifications required to the model!**
