To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound E8A/E8B or E9A/E9B model (announced in July 2008), you'll want to install a TSU-1100 EMD decoder.



If you have an E8A/E8B or E9A/E9B model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 885001. **This installation may take upward of three hours with multiple modifications required to the model.**
