To add a SoundTraxx Tsunami2 Digital Sound Decoder to your non-sound 2-8-2 Mikado model (2007 and later releases) you'll want to install a TSU-1100 Steam-2 decoder.



If you have a 2-8-2 Mikado model without sound that you would like to upgrade, purchase SoundTraxx P.N. 884006. This board is designed to replace the factory PCB that supplies power to the locomotive. **This installation may take upwards of three hours to complete with multiple modifications required to the model!**
